RULING

DISPOSITION: RESPONSE TO MOTIONS DUE FEBRUARY 9, 2018

On February 2, 2018, defendants filed three motions in these dockets. The first two seek either a stay of these proceedings or an extension of time to answer the complaint, until after resolution of a motion to dismiss related to the same dispute in federal court, or, alternatively, an opportunity to file a motion to dismiss in lieu of an answer. Defendants state that the complainant, Portland General Electric Company, (PGE) opposes those requests.

The third motion seeks expedited consideration of the first two motions. Defendants state that PGE supports this motion, and has agreed to file a response on February 9, 2018. The motion for expedited consideration is granted. PGE's response to the first two motions is due February 9, 2018.
