MEMORANDUM

Oral argument on the summary judgment motions of Defendants, Complainants, and Intervenors in this docket is scheduled for March 14, 2019, beginning at 9:30 a.m. and will end no later than 12:30 p.m. Any party to this proceeding may participate in the oral argument.

Complainants and Defendants/Intervenors shall have 30 minutes each to present on issues as they determine appropriate, with an additional 10 minutes each for rebuttal. At the election of the presenter, allotted time may be divided to allow several presenters for each period. Parties may use power point presentations during their allotted time. All presentations must be submitted to the Commission by noon on March 11, 2019.

After each thirty-minute argument, the Commissioners, the Administrative Law Judge, or Commission Counsel may ask the presenting party to respond to questions raised by the testimony, briefs, and oral argument. Argument may also be interrupted for questions.

With regard to the order of argument, eligible parties are scheduled to present, as follows: Complainant Portland General Electric Company; followed by Defendants/Intervenors NewSun QF Parties, the Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition, the Renewable Energy Coalition, and the Community Renewable Energy Association. Rebuttal will follow the same order.
