**MOTION TO SUSPEND PORTIONS  
OF NET VARIABLE POWER COSTS  
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

***EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION  
REQUESTED***

Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420(2), Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”) hereby moves the Administrative Law Judge for an order suspending the portion of the procedural schedule in this docket regarding net variable power cost testimony, briefing and hearing schedule.

On June 28 and 29, 2018, PGE, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, the Oregon Citizens’ Utility Board , and the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers<sup>1</sup>, (collectively the “Settling Parties”) participated in settlement conferences regarding net variable power cost issues. No other parties have raised issues in this docket regarding net variable power costs. At the end of the conferences, an agreement in principle was reached resolving all issues in this docket related to net variable power costs.

In the Prehearing Conference Memorandum issued on March 20, 2018 in this docket, two procedural schedules were adopted, one for issues related to net variable power costs, and the other for other general rate case issues. Consistent with the settlement, PGE requests that the portion of the procedural schedule requiring the filing of testimony, briefs, and a hearing addressing net variable power costs be suspended. PGE will continue to file the MONET power

costs updates as noted in the established schedule, and does not request that those dates be suspended. The Settling Parties support this motion.

Under the procedural schedule in this docket, Staff and Intervenors' rebuttal testimony on the net variable power cost issues is due on July 13, 2018. Accordingly, PGE requests expedited consideration of this motion.
