**MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE**

***EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION
REQUESTED***

Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420(2), Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”) hereby moves the Administrative Law Judge for an order modifying the procedural schedule in this docket.

Most of the issues raised in this docket have been settled. Four Stipulations have been filed, and a fifth Stipulation will be filed very soon. Pursuant to the procedural schedule set in this docket, PGE’s Surrebuttal Testimony will be filed Friday, September 7. It will address the handful of remaining issues in this docket: proposed decoupling changes, PGE’s major storm balancing account proposal, the inclusion of renewable related storage costs through Schedule 122, and the use of trended weather in PGE’s load forecast. A contested settlement of direct access issues is being addressed on a separate schedule.

The next actions scheduled for this docket are the filing of an issues list by September 10, Prehearing Briefs on September 12, and a hearing on September 20 and 21. Given the limited number of issues, and the type of issues remaining, PGE requests that the procedural schedule be amended as follows:

1. That the date for Prehearing Briefs be removed from the schedule, and
2. That the parties be directed to file cross-examination statements, and cross-examination exhibits, if any, by September 14. If, after the filing of cross-

examination statements, it appears that a hearing will be necessary, then a date for a Prehearing Brief could be set if the Commission desires such briefs.

PGE requests no other changes to the schedule set in this docket.

Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board and the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers support this motion. No other parties filed Rebuttal Testimony in this docket.

As discussed above, under the current procedural schedule in this docket, Prehearing Briefs are due on September 12. Accordingly, PGE requests expedited consideration of this motion.
