RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On October 26, 2023, Idaho Power Company filed motions to allow Megan Goicoechea Allen and Donovan Walker to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavits of Ms. Allen and Mr. Walker accompanied the motion. Ms. Allen and Mr. Walker state that they will associate with Adam Lowney, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motions for admission *pro hac vice* and find that they comply with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motions to admit Megan Goicoechea Allen and Donovan Walker as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Idaho Power Company are granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
