**DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED FOR LIMITED PURPOSES**

On October 16, 2021, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers filed a petition to intervene in this docket.

This proceeding is not a contested case proceeding under ORS 183.310(2). Nonetheless, obtaining party status is necessary for purposes of being on the eDockets “service list” that is used for electronic mail notifications of filings made and documents issued. Party status is also necessary to become a signatory to a protective order. For those reasons, the Commission will grant the petition to intervene in proceedings using a Public Meeting decision making process.
