Idaho Power Company 2023 Low-Income Bill Assistance Program proposal and Weatherization Expansion

Summary

At the last check-in with Idaho Power Company in September of this year, Idaho Power invited Hassan Shaban from Empower Dataworks to share the findings of the low-income needs assessment (LINA) within Idaho Power's service territory and dialogue with stakeholders on any questions. At this same check-in, Idaho Power shared some ideas for a proposed income qualified bill assistance program. Since then, parties have filed comments in response to the initial proposal. Filed comments as well as previous workshop materials and the completed LINA are posted to Oregon Public Utility Commission's HB 2475 implementation Docket No. UM 2211 eDockets page (<https://apps.puc.state.or.us/edockets/DocketNoLayout.asp?DocketID=23122>).
