DISPOSITION: CORRECTION TO APRIL 11, 2022 RULING ON MOTIONS TO  
CONSOLIDATE GRANTED IN PART; DENIED IN PART

On April 11, 2022, I issued a ruling in the above referenced dockets, granting the requests from PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power, and Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC) to consolidate certain pending deferral applications with the company's pending 2023 general rate case (GRC), docket UE 399. In that ruling, I also denied CUB's request to consolidate PacifiCorp's deferral request for operating costs and capital investments to implement its Distribution System Plan (docket UM 2220). In its response to PacifiCorp's motion for consolidation, Staff indicated that it intended to address amortization of the 2020 and 2021 calendar year deferrals of costs associated with the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (docket UM 2063), but did not request to consolidate that docket with the GRC.

Due to a typographical error, the language of my April 11, 2022 ruling incorrectly omits docket UM 2201 from and incorrectly includes docket UM 2063 within the list of consolidated dockets. Accordingly, I correct my April 11, 2022 ruling to confirm that docket UM 2063 was not consolidated with docket UE 399 and that docket UM 2201 was consolidated with docket UE 399. I note that this does not foreclose parties from raising issues related to the deferred COVID-19 costs in this GRC. I clarify that the April 11, 2022 order consolidated the following dockets with UE 399: UM 1964, UM 2134, UM 2142, UM 2167, UM 2185, UM 2186, and UM 2201.
