Re: Notice of Interest, PacifiCorp Advice No. 23-016, Rule 13 - Line Extensions (Docket No. ADV 1534)

Dear Commission Staff:

We write on behalf of Amazon Data Services, Inc. (“ADS”) to submit this notice of interest to the Oregon Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) with regard to PacifiCorp Advice No. 23-016 (the “Advice Filing”). ADS requests interested person status pursuant to OAR § 860-001-0300(7) and requests that the Commission provide a formal process for stakeholder engagement with regard to this matter.

PacifiCorp has submitted proposed tariff revisions related to PacifiCorp’s General Rules and Regulations Rule 13 - Line Extensions, with a requested effective date of October 4, 2023. PacifiCorp’s proposed revisions to its tariff will have a direct and significant effect on ADS.

ADS is a corporation that is wholly owned by Amazon.com, Inc. (“Amazon”). Amazon is the largest corporate purchaser of renewable energy globally. ADS’s operations include large infrastructure facilities that are or will be located within the Oregon service territory of PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power (“PacifiCorp”), including data centers like those specifically referenced in PacifiCorp’s current tariff filing. As Amazon stays on a path of powering its operations with 100% renewable energy by 2025, ADS is actively evaluating potential future renewable energy projects located within PacifiCorp’s territory as well. ADS is interested in matters before the Commission that will facilitate or impact the realization of these projects.

ADS intends to participate in the Commission’s evaluation of the proposed tariff change. If the matter remains on the advice filing docket, ADS intends to participate in the process afforded and requests that the Commission hold a stakeholder meeting or workshop, and set a

written comment schedule. If the Commission sets this matter as a contested case, ADS intends to petition for intervenor status.
