RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

The Utility Reform Project (URP) seeks an additional three-day extension of time to file surrebuttal testimony. Because of the late ruling on Portland General Electric’s Motion to Strike, and conflicting commitments of its witness, URP requests that surrebuttal testimony be due on August 1, 2005. URP has conferred with PGE, and reports that PGE did not oppose the request so long as it could file surrebuttal on August 23, 2005, and that the hearing would not be postponed.

URP’s request is granted. The extension also applies to the Commission Staff. All surrebuttal testimony shall be due on August 1, 2005. PGE’s surrebuttal testimony shall be due on August 26, 2005. The hearing will be held on August 29, 2005.
