Dear Judge Logan:

To resolve ongoing issues related to inter-jurisdictional cost allocation, including compliance with the conditions in Order 05-021 regarding development of a Hybrid cost allocation method, PacifiCorp plans to hold Revised Protocol workshops with stakeholders from its six-state service territory. PacifiCorp expects that confidential information may be produced and discussed in this context.

The Commission entered its Standard Protective Order in Phase 2 of UM 1050 in Order 03-638 (Oct 31, 2003). Under that Order, the Commission indicated that the duration of the provisions of the Protective Order would be two years from the date of the final order, unless extended by the Commission at the request of the party desiring confidentiality. In the interest of judicial economy, PacifiCorp proposes to have parties from the Multi-State Process Docket sign the enclosed "Exhibit A" to extend the Protective Order issued in Docket No. UM 1050 to cover the MSP implementation process. We assume that these signed exhibits, in conjunction with this letter, constitute sufficient notice to extend the duration of the UM 1050 Protective Order to cover this process.
