B. CONDITIONS

- 1) Under joint user service, a customer may permit another person, firm, or corporation to share in the use of the customer's telephone service.
- 2) Joint user service will be furnished only with private branch exchange service and one-party business service.
- 3) The customer will be responsible for all charges incurred by the joint user.
- 4) Joint user service will be provided upon application by the customer for the joint user who is located on the premises, in the same office, or in the same suite of the offices as the customer.
- 5) Additional listings and supplemental services may be furnished to the joint user at the request of the customer and at regular rates. The customer's primary service will not be extended to another premises for the use of the joint user.
- 6) The charge for the joint user includes a directory listing in the alphabetical portion of the directory.
- 7) Joint user service is not furnished in connection with foreign exchange service or service stations.

- 2) This service is provided from any of our exchanges for individual business line or PBX services, (except public and semi-public telephone service.)
- 3) This service includes the listing of a special number in both the published directory and information records of the exchange or exchanges from which calls are to be accepted.
- 4) The service may be non-published at the option of the customer under that portion of this tariff.
- 5) The charges for each message will be billed to the customer of this service at the regular sent-paid station rate.
