### **PROJECT OVERVIEW**

Frontier Communications owns and operates a carrier-class data network that supplies data transport services to access devices that deliver internet services to our Oregon customers. Frontier currently operates and maintains a fiber to the home broadband network (FiOS) that serves customers in Clackamas, Multnomah, Washington and Yamhill Counties. This is a passive optical GPON network that provides the flexibility of increasing broadband speeds by augmenting equipment in the Frontier Central Office. Frontier is already providing a-symmetrical gigabit service is some areas of the Oregon FiOS service area. In addition, the existing FiOS broadband network is providing symmetrical speeds to residential broadband customers up to 150mbps/150mbps based on current market demand.

Frontier's application is project based and the proposed project and planned capital investment will enable a large portion of its FiOS footprint to provide symmetrical broadband service of at least, approximately one gigabit per second ("qualified service"). Should this application be approved, Frontier plans to complete the capital investment in 2016 that will make the qualified service available to the majority of its residential broadband customers.

Included as Appendix A of this application is a notarized affidavit of Trent Anderson, Senior Vice President and General Manager of Oregon Operations, certifying that the project meets the requirements of Oregon law.

Included as Appendix B of this application is Frontier's written commitment regarding use of third-parties in service delivery.

Included as Appendix C of the application are confidential paper maps, and a confidential electronic version with GIS-compatible map layers of the area to be served including County and City labels and boundaries.

Included as Appendix D is a confidential list of Oregon municipalities and counties where the project will be located, including the name and contact information, to the best of our ability, for the representative of each such municipality and county that is most knowledgeable with respect to the applicant's project.

Included as Appendix E is confidential list, in Excel format, of the census blocks planned to be served by the project and for each census block, the number of occupied households (using the most current available U.S. Census statistics), and the number of those occupied households that will have access to the services enabled by this project.


