Re: Eugene Rate Center Numbering Waiver Request

By this letter Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC ("CenturyLink") is requesting a waiver of the utilization requirements outlined in FCC's Numbering Resource Optimization Orders, FCC 00-429 and FCC 01-362 released in CC Docket No 99-200, which would allow PA/Neustar, the Number Pooling Administrator, to assign 4 blocks of numbers that meet the specific needs of a customer. The customer specific information is provided in Confidential Attachment A. This document is confidential due to propriety network information, and is appropriately marked and printed on yellow paper.

In our effort to satisfy this request, CenturyLink submitted a request to PA/Neustar on June 7, 2017 for additional numbering resources. That application and the subsequent denial have been provided as Confidential Attachment B, also appropriately marked and printed on yellow paper. Confidential Attachments A and B are sealed in a separate envelope and are being sent to the Commission via regular U.S. Mail. In order for the request to be approved, CenturyLink will require a waiver of the current usage threshold for new numbering requests.

The FCC allows for a waiver of the rules when there is demonstrated need such as a specific customer request for a large block of numbers or to establish an LRN. The waiver process is specifically addressed in the FCC Third Report and

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Order ("Order") as the "safety valve" process (See FCC 01-362, ¶¶ 57-66), which went into effect on March 14, 2002. The order delegates the authority to hear claims for waivers to the state commissioners and recommends that state commissions act expeditiously. The Order proposes that state commissions review a waiver within 10 business days. (See ¶¶ 61, 66).

CenturyLink respectfully requests that the Commission approve the request for a waiver of months to exhaust and Rate Center Utilization requirements, and direct PA/Neustar to assign four blocks out of the existing 458 NPA Eugene Rate Center to accommodate the customer's request.

## Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local

Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia Technologies, Inc. dba iconectiv (iconectiv<sup>TM</sup>) LERG<sup>TM</sup> Routing Guide<sup>xi</sup>. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN of its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric NECA-assigned Company Code or a four-character alphanumeric identifier assigned by the iconectiv<sup>TM</sup> Telecom Routing Administration (TRA).
