recovery for the Study.³ This filing is made in order to provide for deferred accounting treatment of the costs associated with the Study, to implement the Commission's order so that NW Natural can recover these expenses in the future.

Following the issuance of the Order, NW Natural, the Staff of the Commission, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, and the Northwest Industrial Gas Users formed a steering committee ("Steering Committee"), as directed by the Commission. The Steering Committee convened several times for the purpose of hiring a third party independent evaluator. On August 11, 2016, the Steering Committee issued an RFP to an agreed upon list of potential independent evaluators. The Steering Committee interviewed three responders to the RFP and agreed to hire one of the consultants to perform the study. NW Natural, with guidance from the Steering Committee, is currently negotiating a contract for the Study with that consultant. NW Natural anticipates the consultant will begin performing the Study in January 2017, and therefore, seeks deferred accounting treatment for the costs of these services.

E. Reasons for Application for Deferred Accounting – OAR 860-027-0300(3)(b).

ORS 757.259 is a "statutorily authorized exception to the general prohibition against retroactive ratemaking" that allows a "means to address utility expenses or revenues outside of the utility's general rate case proceeding.⁴ Under ORS 757.259(2)(e), the Commission has discretion to authorize a deferral of "[i]dentifiable utility expenses or revenues, the recovery or refund of which the commission finds should be deferred in order to . . . match appropriately the costs borne by and benefits received by rate payers." To determine whether an expense or revenue should be deferred, the Commission "utilizes a flexible, fact-specific approach that acknowledges

the wide range of reasons why deferred accounting might be beneficial to
customers " ⁵

As described above, the Commission ordered the Study to "more robustly examine the risks, costs, and benefits of NW Natural's optimization activities, the assets being utilized for those activities, the allocation between regulated and unregulated services, and the various components of NW Natural's system that drive the costs and revenues associated with interstate storage services." In the Order, the Commission authorized NW Natural to recover the costs of the Study. NW Natural files this deferral application to ensure that it has taken the steps necessary to allow the Commission's authorized rate recovery to be implemented.

F. Accounting – OAR 860-027-0300(3)(c).

Beginning on January 5, 2017, and ending 12 months from this date, NW Natural proposes to account for the costs associated with the consultant by recording the deferral in Account 186420. In the absence of approval of deferred accounting, NW Natural would record the amounts in an operations and maintenance account affecting the Company's income statement.

G. Estimated Accounts Subject to Deferral – OAR 860-027-0300(3)(d).

NW Natural estimates that approximately \$239,200 will be recorded in the deferred account for the 12-month period subsequent to this Application. This amount is based on a preliminary estimate provided by the consultant and may change during the deferral period.
