RE: UPN 19 PacifiCorp Notice of Property Disposition—Sale of Equipment

Under ORS 757.480(2), PacifiCorp d/b/a/ Pacific Power (PacifiCorp or Company) provides notice of the disposition of property necessary or useful in the provision of utility service (Notice).

Bridger Coal Company (BCC) sold the following items that had been used at the Bridger Coal Mine site to through an auction sale: (i) 2002 Freightliner FL60 Mechanics Service Truck; (ii) 1991 White/GMC/Autocar ACL T/A Lube Truck; (iii) 1999 Volvo/Autocar ACL64B T/A Cab & Chassis; (iv) 2000 Ford F750 Flatbed Truck; (v) two Auto Crane 3200# Material Cranes & hose reels; (vi) Auto Crane 3200# Material Crane (unmounted); (vii) 1992 Caterpillar 16G Articulating Motor Grader; and (viii) Hotsy HCR506R Portable Steam Cleaner/Pressure Washer (collectively, the Equipment). Pacific Minerals, Inc., is a direct, wholly-owned subsidiary of PacifiCorp that holds a 66.67 percent interest in BCC. BCC is the primary coal supplier to the Jim Bridger power plant located in southwest Wyoming. The Equipment was no longer needed by BCC and had been fully depreciated. The Equipment was sold at auction by JJ Kane Auctioneers, to a single buyer, on August 25, 2016. The auction company considers the name of the purchaser to be proprietary information. This information is provided as confidential pursuant to OAR 860-01-0070.

The total value received for the Equipment was \$60,750, with PacifiCorp's 66.67 percent share being \$40,500. The sale of the Equipment will not interfere with PacifiCorp's ability to operate its facilities. The public is not harmed because PacifiCorp will continue to be able to fulfill its obligation to provide safe, reliable electric service.
