PACIFIC POWER'S RESPONSE TO PETITION FOR DECLARATORY RULING

Petition for Declaratory Ruling.

1 Under OAR 860-001-0400 and OAR 860-001-0430, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power 2 (Pacific Power or the Company) submits this preliminary response to the April 10, 2015 3 Petition for Declaratory Ruling (Petition) filed by Georgia-Pacific (Camas) LLC (GP Camas) 4 and Clatskanie People's Utility District (CPUD). In the Petition, GP Camas and CPUD 5 (collectively the Joint Petitioners) request that the Public Utility Commission of Oregon 6 (Commission) determine whether the: (1) CPUD is subject to Oregon's direct access laws, 7 specifically ORS 757.672(2), and therefore may provide service to GP Camas without 8 becoming a certified Electric Service Supplier (ESS); and (2) CPUD's proposed service to 9 GP Camas violates Oregon's exclusive service territory laws, contained in ORS 758.450(2). 10 Because the Joint Petitioners present important legal and policy questions, Pacific 11 Power respectfully requests the Commission substantively consider the petition and set a 12 schedule for briefing and oral arguments. Pacific Power further supports the Joint 13 Petitioners' request for expedited consideration of the petition. To allow for expedited 14 consideration, Pacific Power requests briefing begin in early June 2015.
