Bench Request 1

When PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power) filed its initial application in this docket, it also provided Highly Confidential work papers to Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) and parties that signed Special Protective Order No. 10-148. However, the work papers were not submitted as an exhibit for inclusion in the record.
