9	In accordance with the Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ) Ruling issued August 21,		
10	2015, staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) files this Position Statement		
11.	regarding matters related to the hearing set for August 25, 2015.		
12	First, Staff does not object to any of the hearing exhibits submitted by the parties.		
13	Second, Staff objects to Noble Energy Solutions, LLC's (Noble) request to present live		
14	rebuttal testimony of its witness Kevin Higgins. Allowing live rebuttal testimony is inconsistent		
15	with usual Commission hearing practice, which relies upon multiple rounds of extensive written		
16	testimony and exhibits. This makes sense because the issues presented in Commission		
17	proceedings are frequently highly-complex, which lends itself to presentation of written		
18	B testimony in order to allow all parties to understand, and explore, each party's position. The		
19	issues in this case are no exception. Because of the complexity of the issues, it would be very		
20	difficult to absorb and react to live rebuttal testimony presented for the first time at hearing.		
21	Staff is not persuaded that Noble has established valid reasons for being allowed the		
22	unusual step of presenting live rebuttal testimony. Staff believes that Noble should be able to		
23	establish the facts it desires by means of cross examination of other parties' witnesses.		
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1	For these reasons, Staff requests that the ALJ deny Noble's request.
