Malia:

You may, or may not, include the following comments in your meeting with the PUC tomorrow. I'll leave that decision up to you.

I know I have commented until I am blue in the face regarding both how it is unfair, and unreasonable for those property owners at PP who have spent thousands of dollars on updating and maintaining the water system, to only have it trashed by certain property owners, and have no recourse through the PUC. My feelings on this matter have not changed.

We now, again, must come up with thousands of dollars, but those dollars are not being used to replace the original system. The majority of those dollars are being used to, for lack of a better word, "protect" the wells and what's left of the tank farm, from the perpetrators who trashed the system to begin with! The perpetrators have already shown their ability to divert water, shut off water, and otherwise vandalize the water system at their whim. I, for one, believe that the proposed money, and efforts that are to be expended, only "up" the challenge to the perpetrator. And, very unfortunately, as you have explained, the PUC has no legal authority to prosecute such individuals, should this type of vandalism, etc., continue. I had to laugh when I read Mrs. Macaluso's comments in her email to the PUC where she stated that many of the reasons the PUC was brought into PP have been eliminated, and that she was confident that we would be able to manage the water system without the involvement of a regent.
