Public Utility Commission Legislature Report to Comply with HB 2893)

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments into the Draft Report to the Legislature regarding effectiveness of solar programs in Oregon. PGE appreciates the balanced approach reflected in the draft.

HB 2893 requires that the Commission "make recommendations for modifying the programs or establishing new programs for the purpose of providing incentives for the development of solar photovoltaic energy systems in a manner that is cost effective and protects ratepayers, including ratepayers that do not participate in the programs." PGE is uncertain whether the policy issues identified in Chapter 7 of the report (recovery of utility fixed costs, integrating distributed solar reliably through use of smart inverters, and reducing soft costs) were intended by the Commission to be viewed as recommendations for future programs or policies that the legislature could investigate. To the extent that the Commission intends those issues to receive further review by the legislature, PGE believes that the narrative in Chapter 7 should be recast to make that intention more explicit. In doing so, we believe that the mandate required by HB 2893 would be met.

Again, PGE appreciates the opportunity to comment and looks forward to continued participation in this docket.
