I write regarding Docket #349, Global Partners proposal to purchase nine oil tanks and an oil pipeline connecting the tanks to a dock on the Columbia River.

I understand that Oregon Public Utilities Commission has the final say on whether Global Partners can purchase the massive oil storage tanks from a neighboring industrial site at Port Westward, near Clatskanie, Oregon.

I respectfully request that my statement in this email be entered as an objection to that purchase. Risking environmental and human damage along the mighty Columbia River is not consistent with the public interest.

Oil tanks and oil pipelines all leak and all cause environmental damage. It is not a question of "if" they will leak, it is a question of "when" they will leak. There is not a single case that proves otherwise.

Earth is in peril, a global warming crisis brought on by human extraction and use of fossil fuels. The US made commitments at the Paris Agreement to lower carbon emissions. And though the current US president recently withdrew from the Paris Agreements, the State of Oregon has made a decision to join other states in fulfilling those climate commitments made at the Paris Agreement.
