RE: UM 1631 PGE Compliance Report for Partial Waiver of 860-039-0030(3) Requirements for Net Metering Level 1 Applications

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) hereby submits this compliance filing pursuant to Order No. 22-502 approving PGE's request to waive OAR 860-039-0030(3) requirement that a Level 1 net metering customer's application be rejected if it fails to meet one or more of the applicable criteria. PGE was directed by Order No. 22-502 to file a report on the results of the waiver by July 1, 2023.

Below are the results PGE's use of the waiver between January 15, 2023, to June 15, 2023.

Rationale for waiver: In each case it was determined that despite failure of the 15% threshold of annual peak load, the projects could be interconnected without risk to the safety and reliability of the distribution system. Thus, none of the projects failed and required to conduct additional study.
