RE: UE 300 - Withdrawal of Advice No. 15-09, Rule C Customer Attachment to Facilities

Portland General Electric (PGE) originally filed Advice No. 15-09 on April 3, 2105, with a requested effective date of May 20, 2015. Supplemental Filings were made on April 6, 2015, May 13, 2016, June 24, 2016, July 1, 2015, and October 9, 2015.

By Commission Order No. 15-227, PGE's Advice No. 15-09 was suspended for further investigation not to exceed six months from August 12, 2015. The six months expired on February 12, 2016. PGE filed a Supplemental filing January 27, 2016 requesting the suspension be extended from February 12, 2016 to May 12, 2016 to allow parties time to resolve outstanding issues. PGE now withdraws Advice No. 15-09 in its entirety.

The Company may submit a new filing for Rule C Customer Attachment to Facilities under a new advice number following the Court of Appeals decision on the pending case of Bull Mountain Meadows, LLC, v. Frontier Communications and the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Appellate Court No. A157250; OPUC Docket UM 1669), filed mid-2014.

In deciding the case, the Court of Appeals may offer a standard or guidance on whether and when a developer may be treated as an agent of the City for the purpose of developer-driven relocations, removals or rearrangements of PGE facilities in the right-of-way. If guidance is provided, that could then inform our tariff language.

PGE submits this Withdrawal Filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes 756.010(8) and 757.205.
