Re: UM 1354- Qwest's Notice of Reallocation of \$1 Million from OTCIC to Network Infrastructure Projects (DSL Deployments)


Dear Chairman Baum, Commissioners Savage and Ackerman, and Judge Arlow:

This is to notify and advise the Commission that the Citizens' Utilities Board, Qwest and Commission Staff have agreed that Qwest will reallocate \$1 million of the \$2 million originally committed for the Oregon Telecommunications Consumer Information Center (OTCIC), pursuant to the Commission's Order No. 08-408 dated August 8, 2008 ("Order") in Docket UM 1354, to incremental improvements to Qwest's network, such as further DSL deployment.

In the Order, the Commission approved the parties' agreement that Qwest would make \$4 million in network infrastructure improvements, which included *up to* \$2 million for a Consumer Information Center, as part of Qwest's Price Plan. CUB and Qwest have agreed that CUB will operate the OTCIC within the parameters of a recently-filed stipulation and agreement. CUB and Qwest have also agreed that only \$1 million of the original \$2 million allocated to the OTCIC is required to commence and operate the OTCIC for the remaining three years of Qwest's five-year Price Plan. Accordingly, Qwest will now use the remaining \$1 million for further network infrastructure improvements, and will initiate these deployments after the initial DSL deployments to which it has committed have been completed, but before the end of the Price Plan. Qwest will, of course, work with Staff to determine appropriate projects for funding.

Qwest respectfully requests that the Commission acknowledge this notice.
