The Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU") files this Notice of Intent to Request an Issue Fund Grant in Docket No. UM 1662, pursuant to OAR § 860-001-0120 and the Second Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IFA"), approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission") in Order No. 12-452 (November 7, 2012).

- 1. On June 19, 2013, Portland General Electric ("PGE") and PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power ("PacifiCorp") (collectively, the "Companies") filed with the Commission a request for a generic investigation into the power cost adjustment mechanisms ("PCAMs") now in place for the Companies. The Commission docketed the filing as Docket No. UM 1662. On March 21, 2014, following discussions with Commission Staff, the Citizens' Utility Board and ICNU, the Companies filed a narrower request for an investigation into the recovery of all costs incurred by the Companies to comply with Oregon's Renewable Portfolio Standard.
- 2. ICNU opposes opening an investigation into the Companies' PCAMs. If the Commission opens an investigation, ICNU will seek intervenor funding. Prior to adopting a

schedule, ICNU requests that the parties be allowed to address whether this investigation is

warranted.

3. UM 1662 is an Eligible Proceeding under the IFA. The IFA defines an

Eligible Proceeding as "any Commission proceeding that directly affects one or more of the

Participating Public Utilities." IFA, Section 1(c). UM 1662 will directly affect PGE and

PacifiCorp, which are Participating Public Utilities under Section 1(k) of the IFA. Therefore, an

Issue Fund Grant may be made for this proceeding under Section 6.1 the IFA.

4. As required by Section 6.2 of the IFA, this Notice of Intent is being filed

at the time ICNU is requesting intervention in UM 1662.

5. As required by Section 6.2 of the IFA, this Notice of Intent is being served

on each affected Participating Public Utility, all precertified organizations, and all parties

identified on the service list from UM 1662.

6. ICNU identifies the PGE and PacifiCorp Issue Fund Accounts as the

accounts from which ICNU intends to request the Issue Fund Grant.

7. ICNU has been precertified under Sections 5.1 and 5.2 of the IFA and

OAR § 860-001-0120(3)(b), as eligible to receive an Issue Fund Grant, by Commission Order

No. 03-502, which was entered on August 21, 2003.

8. ICNU requests that the Commission establish a deadline by which ICNU

must file a proposed budget with respect to the Issue Fund Grant, as provided in Section 6.3 of

the IFA.
