Re: Boomerang Wireless, LLC d/b/a enTouch Wireless Lifeline Broadband Provider Designation

Dear Mr. Conway:

This notice is to inform the Commission that Boomerang Wireless, LLC d/b/a enTouch Wireless ("Boomerang") received its federal designation as a Lifeline Broadband Provider ("LBP") for the provision of Lifeline Broadband Internet Access Service ("BIAS") on December 1, 2016 (Order No. DA 16-1325).

On March 31, 2016 the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") adopted its Lifeline Modernization Order which included BIAS as a supported Lifeline service and established a 60day streamlined federal LBP designation process under Section 214(e)(6) of the Act. On October 3, 2016, Boomerang filed its application with the FCC for designation of Boomerang as an LBP ETC, and Boomerang was designated on December 1, 2016.

Boomerang received its ETC designation in Oregon in Docket UM-1668 and will continue to operate under that ETC designation within your state. Should a qualifying consumer residing outside of our ETC service area request LBP services, Boomerang is obligated to provide those services.
