4	For The Taking Of Official Notice of its UM 1707 Brief. In accordance with its request for
5	expedited consideration of its Motion, CUB also respectfully requests that the time for responses

CUB's interest in this matter is based upon its active participation in both IRP and rate case filings in Oregon. The amount of information that is designated as confidential information, by Oregon utilities, grows exponentially every year. CUB frequently does not have the time to challenge information individual confidentiality designations and so long as the designation does not inhibit CUB's ability to review and present the information in question to the Commission, CUB has over the years, frequently failed to contest sketchy designations.

Today the issue of the designation of confidential information by PacifiCorp is squarely before this Commission and CUB wishes to encourage the Commission to carefully review the issue of the use of umbrella protective orders for the protection of true "trade secrets" and truly "commercially sensitive information." It is CUB's belief that much of what the utilities designate as confidential would, on closer inspection, prove to be possibly embarrassing, possibly revealing in terms of what a utility knew and when it knew it, but not really a trade secret or commercially sensitive information. How can ten, five, three or even one year old dates on contracts be either a trade secret or commercially sensitive? How could the name of a
