8	Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420 and the Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) April 5,				
9	2018 ruling in this proceeding, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) moves				
10	to modify the procedural schedule for the remainder of this docket.				
11	Currently, the remaining events for this proceeding are scheduled as follows:

17	At the pre-hearing conference held in this matter on April 4, 2018, Staff proposed that the				
18	hearing be set for a date two weeks after the date of Tillamook County's decision regarding the				
19	pending permit application related to approval of the proposed transmission line. The matter was				
20	taken under advisement, and on April 5, 2018, the ALJ issued a ruling directing Staff to present				
21	its request in the form of a motion with supporting argument, and allowing the other parties time				
22	to respond. Staff's request is supported by the following points and authorities.				
23	BACKGROUND				
24	Tillamook People's Utility District (TPUD) filed a Petition for a Certification of Public				
25	Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon				
26	(Commission) on October 6, 2017. TPUD included with the Petition a partial copy of the				
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1162 Court Street NE Salem, OR 97301-4096 (503) 947-4342 / Fax: (503) 378-3784 consolidated application for permits that TPUD had filed in August 2017 with the Tillamook
County Planning Commission related to land use approval for the Tillamook to Oceanside 115
kV transmission line project, including a conditional use permit application.¹ The Tillamook
County Planning Commission initially scheduled its proceeding for hearing on February 8, 2018,
then the matter was continued to March 8, 2018, and now to April 26, 2018.² TPUD recently
agreed to an extension of the statutory deadline for a decision by Tillamook County to July 13,
2018.³

DISCUSSION

9 Staff requests that a hearing be scheduled in this matter for a date two weeks after 10 Tillamook County's decision on the pending conditional use permit application. Currently, that 11 decision is required by July 13, 2018. There are three reasons that support Staff's request. First, 12 the County's decision, while not required, would be relevant to this proceeding. The 13 Commission makes its findings regarding the project's compatibility with land use regulations 14 under OAR 860-025-0030(a) - (d). Under OAR 860-025-0030(a), a copy of the local land use permit from each affected city or county stating the proposed project has received the 15 16 jurisdiction's approval is one method for the Commission to make its land use findings. Other 17 methods may be used to make the Commission's land use findings, but the permit is one. 18 Second, granting Staff's request will ensure efficiency in the administrative process. A 19 CPCN, once issued, may be used as evidence in condemnation proceedings for specific interests in land, as noted in ORS 758.015(2). But, depending on the result of the County planning 20 21 process, TPUD may need to consider a different or altered route. If the route is altered after this 22 proceeding has been resolved, the hearing will have been unnecessary and any Commission 23 order approving this CPCN may need to be withdrawn, or a second petition for a CPCN filed.

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1 TPUD submitted its application to Tillamook County before it filed the Petition. Ordinarily, the

2 County's decision would have been issued by this time, but the hearing has twice been

continued. Staff appreciates TPUD's efforts to coordinate multiple applications, but believes the
proposed schedule below to be most efficient.

5 Third, granting Staff's request will ensure a hearing is conducted on the Petition in 6 approximately three months. This is not a significant delay. The County's decision on the 7 permit application would be an administrative ruling subject to official notice per OAR 860-001-8 0460, which allows for scheduling a hearing within two weeks of the decision.

Based on the foregoing, Staff proposes a hearing date be set during the week of July 30,
2018, or later, as may be convenient for the Commission. At the April 4, 2018 pre-hearing
conference, TPUD expressed a preference for three rounds of post-hearing briefs. Staff has no
objection, and therefore, includes dates for post-hearing briefing in the following proposed
schedule, subject to comment by parties:
