PACIFICORP'S SECOND MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULE

For all of the reasons set forth below, PacifiCorp moves to modify the procedural schedule in this docket as follows, with all other procedural deadlines to remain unchanged:

Event	Current Due Date	Proposed Due Date
PacifiCorp Rebuttal Testimony	June 2, 2005	June 6, 2005
Staff/Intervenor Surrebuttal Testimony	June 22, 2005	June 27, 2005
PacifiCorp Sursurebuttal Testimony	July 8, 2005	July 11, 2005

As good cause for this motion, PacifiCorp notes the following:

- The hearing date set in the original schedule in this case was Monday, July 18,
 2005. PacifiCorp understands that the hearing is now scheduled two days later, on
 Wednesday, July 20, 2005.
- 2. PacifiCorp's current testimony due date is Thursday, June 2, 2005. Because of witness availability issues caused by the Memorial Day weekend, PacifiCorp needs two additional business days to complete and file its testimony. In light of the fact that the hearing has now been set back two days, this extension can be accomplished without any party or the Commission losing time already allotted to them in the schedule.
 - 3. PacifiCorp also understands that the ALJ in the case intends to ask the parties to file prehearing briefs on July 13, 2005. To allow parties an opportunity to review PacifiCorp's sursurrebuttal before filing of these briefs, PacifiCorp's request for

3		date that would result from a two-business day extension.
4	4.	At ICNU's request, PacifiCorp has agreed to commit to a best efforts, 5-day
5		turnaround on data requests directed at its sursurrebuttal testimony.
6	5.	PacifiCorp contacted Staff, CUB, ICNU and Fred Meyer about this extension.
7		None of these parties oppose the request. PacifiCorp regrets any burden or
8		inconvenience this request for extension causes and appreciates the willingness of
9		others to support the request.
