MOTION TO SUSPEND SCHEDULE [EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUESTED]

Pursuant to OAR 860-013-0031, Portland General Electric ("PGE") requests that the schedule set in this docket be suspended. The parties to this docket, PGE, Staff of the Public Utility Commission ("Staff"), the Citizens' Utility Board ("CUB"), and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU"), (collectively the "Parties"), have reached a settlement in principle of all issues in this docket. The Parties are in the process of drafting a Stipulation to be submitted to the Commission.

Under the current schedule in this docket, Staff and intervenor surrebuttal testimony is due December 23, 2009. Subsequent dates for PGE sur-surrebuttal testimony, a hearing, and post-hearing briefs are also set. PGE, with the support of the other Parties, requests that these deadlines be suspended. The Parties will endeavor to submit a Stipulation as soon as possible for Commission consideration.

EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUEST

For the reasons discussed above, PGE requests that the administrative law judge issue an order suspending the schedule in this docket. Since under the current schedule testimony is due

from some parties next week, expedited consideration of this motion is requested.
