Pursuant to OAR 860-013-0031, Portland General Electric (“PGE”) requests that the schedule set in this docket be modified. A workshop was held in this docket on January 12, 2009, and settlement discussions are scheduled for next week. PGE, Staff of the Public Utility Commission (“Staff”), the Citizens’ Utility Board (“CUB”), and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (“ICNU”), (collectively the “Parties”) participated. Under the current schedule in this docket, Staff and Intervenor testimony is to be filed January 21, 2009. In order to facilitate further discussion among the parties, PGE requests that the schedule in this docket be amended. Specifically, the Parties have agreed to the following proposed schedule:

Reply Briefs:	March 27, 2009

The target deadline for a Commission order would remain May 1, 2009.
