Pursuant to OAR 860-013-0031, Portland General Electric (“PGE”) requests that the procedural schedule set in this docket be suspended. PGE has very recently encountered a delay in the construction of the Selective Water Withdrawal project. PGE needs time to assess the impact of the delay and convey that information to the other parties. Under the current procedural schedule PGE’s reply testimony is due Friday, April 17, 2009, and the hearing is set for April 29, 2009.

PGE requests that the current procedural schedule be suspended. If the schedule is suspended, PGE will work with the other parties and file a request with the Administrative Law Judge regarding scheduling the remainder of this docket by May 15, 2009. Staff of the Public Utility Commission, the Citizens’ Utility Board, and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, the other parties in this docket, support this motion.

EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUEST

For the reasons discussed above, PGE requests that the administrative law judge issue an

order amending the schedule in this docket. Since the first deadline sought changed is later this week, expedited consideration of this motion is requested.
