PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, and 1 the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (collectively the Settling Parties), respectfully request that 2 the Commission suspend the current procedural schedule in docket UE 309, including discovery. 3 4 The Settling Parties have reached a comprehensive settlement in principle on all issues. No other party has intervened in the docket. The Settling Parties intend to file a stipulation documenting 5 6 the settlement. Because there is a settlement in principle that will be supported by a stipulation 7 and joint testimony, there is no need for the process set forth in the procedural schedule adopted on June 16, 2016. 8
