PACIFICORP'S STIPULATED MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

(Expedited Consideration Requested)

In accordance with OAR 860-001-0420, Pacific PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power respectfully requests that the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) issue an order amending the procedural schedule in this docket to remove the requirement that parties file cross-examination statements and cross-examination exhibits on August 3, 2018, and cancel the hearing scheduled for August 7, 2018. Because cross-examination statements and exhibits are due Friday, August 3, 2018, PacifiCorp requests expedited treatment of this motion in accordance with OAR 860-001-0420(6). Staff of the Commission, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, and Calpine Energy Solutions LLC, (collectively with PacifiCorp, the Stipulating Parties) support this motion. No party to this case opposes the motion.

The Stipulating Parties have reached an agreement to mutually waive cross examination, subject to the admission into the record of certain cross-examination exhibits. Through separate motions, the parties will move their cross-examination exhibits into the record, along with their pre-filed testimony and exhibits. Because the Stipulating Parties have agreed to waive cross examination, PacifiCorp requests that the Commission cancel the hearing currently scheduled for August 7, 2018, unless the Administrative Law Judge or Commissioners have questions for the witnesses. PacifiCorp requests that the current briefing schedule remain in place.
