RE: UM 1020 – Portland General Electric Company's Request for an Extension of Contracts for Retail Marketing Services for Residential and Small Commercial Voluntary Renewable Energy Program and Acquisition of Renewable Energy Certificates to Offset Participant Usage

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this request to extend its contracts for retail marketing services for the Residential and Small Commercial Voluntary Renewable Energy Program and acquisition of renewable energy certificates to offset usage participant usage by 12 months. The current contracts go through December 31, 2020; therefore, PGE requests an extension through December 31, 2021.

PGE proposes to extend the existing contracts to allow for time to investigate the Commission's Portfolio Options Committee (POC) in this docket. As of March 1, 2020, the POC and its activities have been suspended and the utilities were advised to use the docket for changes and updates related to their Residential and Small Commercial Voluntary Renewable Energy Programs. This proposal was reviewed, and unanimously recommended for approval, by the POC on February 26, 2020. Further, due to the recent events related to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, PGE suspended all marketing operations in alignment with the Oregon Governor's Executive Orders around COVID-19.
