Under ORCP 36(C)(7) and OAR 860-001-0080(1), PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power

(PacifiCorp or Company) moves the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) for

entry of a standard protective order in this proceeding. Good cause exists to issue a

protective order to protect commercially sensitive and confidential business information

related to master electric service agreements and customer-specific information.

The Commission's rules authorize PacifiCorp to seek reasonable restrictions on

discovery of trade secrets and other confidential business information.

The Commission's

standard protective order is designed to allow the broadest possible discovery consistent with

- the need to protect confidential information.² PacifiCorp requests this protective order to
- 2 facilitate the communication of information between the parties.
- 3 PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power (PacifiCorp), North Hurlburt Wind, LLC. (North
- 4 Hurlburt), and Columbia Basin Electric Cooperative, Inc. (CBEC) were unable to reach joint
- 5 stipulated facts by October 31, 2013, and therefore will be filing opening testimony by
- 6 January 17, 2013, in accordance with the alternate adopted procedural schedule. Issuance of
- 7 a protective order will facilitate the production of relevant information and expedite the
- 8 discovery process.
- 9 For these reasons, PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the Commission enter its
- standard protective order in this docket.
