STAFF MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE

10 Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“Staff”) requests that the
11 administrative law judge modify the procedural schedule in this docket. Under the schedule
12 adopted in this case, Staff was to conduct two workshops on March 26, 2014 and May 13, 2014.

13 The schedule further directs:

14 Following the second workshop, Staff shall file a status report and recommendations with
15 the Commission within ten business days. Interested parties may file comments on Staff’s
filing within five business days.

16 Staff conducted the first workshop on March 26, 2014. On May 8, 2014, counsel for
17 Staff notified the interested persons that Staff would not be able to conduct the second workshop
18 on May 13, 2014 and proposed to reschedule this workshop to June 10, 2014. None of the
19 interested persons objected to this date. Staff intends to issue a notice to interested persons for
20 the second workshop to be conducted on June 10, 2014. Staff moves to modify the schedule to
21 the extent necessary to reflect that Staff will file a status report and recommendations within ten
22 business days of the workshop that will be conducted on June 10, 2014. Interested parties will
23 still have the opportunity to file comments on Staff’s filing within five business days.

24 On May 8, 2014, counsel for Staff sent an e-mail to the service list of this docket and that
25 of Docket No. AR 574 notifying interested persons that Staff would move to modify the schedule
26 as described above. Counsel for Staff did not receive any objections to the proposal in the

1 e-mail, and sent another e-mail on May 12, 2014 confirming that Staff would file this motion.

2 Staff respectfully requests that the procedural schedule be modified to reflect that Staff
3 will file a status report and recommendations within ten business days of the workshop that will
4 be conducted on June 10, 2014. Interested parties will still have the opportunity to file
5 comments on Staff's filing within five business days.


