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8	Pursuant to OAR 860-001-420, NW Natural Gas Company ("NW Natural) requests that		
9	the Commission revise the current schedule in this case. The LDCs filed Opening Testimony		
10	on December 1, 2015, and on February 8, 2016, Staff and Intervenors filed their Opening		
11	Testimony. Currently, the schedule calls for all parties to file reply testimony on March 9,		
12	prior to a Commission workshop on March 30. The schedule also provides for a final round of		
13	reply testimony to be filed by the LDCs, and cross-reply testimony by all parties, on April 11.		
14	The parties attended a settlement con	ference on February 16. At that time, CUB,	
15	NWIGU and Staff all expressed a desire to raise and address a new issue in their reply		
16	testimony on March 9. NW Natural does not object, however would like an opportunity to		
17	respond to that new issue—if appropriate prior to the Commission workshop. For this		
18	reason, NW Natural proposes that the schedule be amended to add a new round of		
19	testimony—to be filed on March 23rd for the LDCs to respond to any new issues raised in the		
20	March 9 testimony. If the LDCs determine that they can effectively respond at the time of the		
21	Commission workshop, they may opt not to file testimony on March 23 <sup>rd</sup> and instead include		
22	their response to the new issues in the testimony scheduled for April 11.		
23	With the requested change, the remainder of the schedule will be as follows:
