18	some early information from the third party facilitator should be available.	
19	Therefore, CenturyLink/Qwest, Integra Telecom of Oregon, Inc., and Commission Staff	
20	agree that the workshop date should be moved to the week of January 27, 2016. These parties	
21	will continue to confer upon an agreeable date and submit notice to the ALJ of the agreed-upon
