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11	Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420(2) and OAR 860-083-0005(2), Staff of the Public Utility		
12	Commission of Oregon (Staff) moves the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) for an order granting		
13	Staff's request to waive the time set by OAR 860-038-0400(8) for filing comments in this		
14	docket. Staff further respectfully requests that the ALJ adopt the procedural schedule agreed to		
15	by the parties in this proceeding.		
16	OAR 860-038-0400(8)(a) provides that Staff and other interested persons may file		
17	written comments on a renewable portfolio implementation plan (RPIP) within 45 calendar days		
18	of its filing, and that the electric company then has 30 days to file a written response to any		
19	comments filed. Under this subsection of the rule, Staff "should present its recommendation at a		
20	Commission public meeting within 120 days of the implementation plan filing date." Id.		
21	OAR 860-083-0005(2) provides that the Commission may waive any of the Division 083		
22	rules upon request or its own motion for good of	cause shown. Given the complexity and	
23	importance of Portland General Electric Company's (PGE) filing in light of the recently enacted		
24	SB 1547, Staff believes there is good cause in this case to waive the provisions in OAR 860-038-		
25	0400(8)(a) in order to allow for additional time for discovery and analysis prior to comments		
26	filed by Staff and intervenors. Staff's proposed schedule, shown below, allows for a final		
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2	Commission action on PGE's RPIP no later than six months after PGE filed its RPIP with the
2	Commission on July 15, 2016, as required by ORS 469A.075(3) and OAR 860-083-0400(8)(c).
45	Staff has conferred with PGE, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities,
	Renewable Northwest, and the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon. No party objects to Staff's
	request for waiver of OAR 860-083-0400(8)(a), and the parties have agreed to the following
