MOTION FOR GENERAL PROTECTIVE ORDER

1 Under ORCP 36(C)(7) and OAR 860-001-0080(1), PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power 2 (PacifiCorp or Company) moves the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) for 3 entry of a general protective order in the Investigation into Schedule 37 – Avoided Cost 4 Purchases from Qualifying Facilities of 10,000 kW or Less proceeding. Good cause exists to 5 issue a Protective Order to protect commercially sensitive and confidential business 6 information in this proceeding. 7 The Commission's rules authorize PacifiCorp to seek reasonable restrictions on discovery of trade secrets and other confidential business information.<sup>1</sup> The Commission's 8 9 general protective order is designed to allow the broadest possible discovery consistent with the need to protect confidential information.<sup>2</sup> PacifiCorp requests this protective order to 10 11 facilitate the communication of information between the parties and expedite the discovery 12 process.
