17	filling related to September 2 and September 3 outages.		
18	Order No. 23-356 directed Lumen to provide a post-incident assessment of the September		
19	2 and September 3 outages that 1) reviews communication challenges and recommends		
20	improvements to benefit customers; 2) describes and provides supporting documentation for,		
21	how Lumen is complying with each requirement of Order Nos. 22-340 and 22-422; and 3)		
22	respond to the proposal made by Priscilla Weaver at the public meeting regarding a Jackson-area		
23	outage triage process. Additionally, the Commission required Staff to review Lumen's		
24	assessment and provide a memorandum and recommendation for the November 16, 2023, public		
25	meeting. On October 23, 2023, Lumen provided its assessment.
