9	Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420(2) and	OAR 860-083-0005(2), Staff of the Public Utility		
10	Commission of Oregon (Staff) moves the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) for an order granting			
11	Staff's request to waive the time set by OAR 860-038-0400(8)(a) for filing comments in this			
12	docket. Staff further respectfully requests that the ALJ adopt the procedural schedule agreed to			
13	by the parties in this proceeding.			
14	OAR 860-038-0400(8)(a) provides that Staff and other interested persons may file			
15	written comments on a renewable portfolio implementation plan (RPIP) within 45 calendar days			
16	of its filing, and that the electric company then has 30 days to file a written response to any			
17	comments filed. Additionally, Staff "should present its recommendation at a Commission public			
18	meeting within 120 days of the implementation plan filing date." Id.			
19	OAR 860-083-0005(2) provides that the Commission may waive any of the Division 083			
20	rules upon request or its own motion for good cause shown. Given the importance of Portland			
21	General Electric Company's (PGE) filing in light of the recently enacted SB 1547, Staff believes			
22	there is good cause in this case to waive the provisions in OAR 860-038-0400(8)(a) in order to			
23	allow for additional time for discovery and analysis prior to comments filed by Staff and			
24	intervenors. Staff's proposed schedule, shown below, allows for a final Commission action on			
25	PGE's RPIP no later than six months after PGE filed its RPIP with the Commission on			
26	6 December 29, 2017, as required by ORS 469A.075(3) and OAR 860-083-0400(8)(c).			
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- Because February 12, 2018 marks 45 days since PGE's RPIP was filed, Staff respectfully
- 2 requests expedited treatment of its motion. Staff has conferred with PGE, the Industrial
- 3 Customers of Northwest Utilities, and Oregon Citizens' Utility Board. No party objects to
- 4 Staff's request for waiver of OAR 860-083-0400(8)(a), which results in the following schedule:
