7	Staff of the Public Utility Commission of	of Oregon (Staff), NW Natural, the Citizens'		
8	Utility Board of Oregon (CUB), and Northwest	Industrial Gas Users (NWIGU) move the		
9	Administrative Hearings Division to adopt an agreed-upon procedural schedule for resolving a			
10	disputed issue in NW Natural's 2011 Spring Earnings Review. OAR 860-022-0070(6)			
11	establishes the process for resolving disputed issues that arise during review of a gas utility's			
12	spring earnings review filing as follows:

14	with the Commission on unresolved issues, if needed. The Commission will issue its decision on unresolved issues, if any, by August 15. Unless otherwise directed by the Commission, each LDC will file its annual gas cost tracking filing by August 31, including amortization of credit amounts in the deferred account, if any, resulting from the earnings review.

18	On June 23, 2011, NW Natural, NWIGU, CUB, and Staff met to discuss a Staff-			
19	proposed adjustment to NW Natural's 2011 earnings. At that time, these parties agreed			
20	to convene a settlement conference (as required by OAR 860-022-0070(6)), on July 6,			
21	2011. CUB, NWIGU, Staff, and NW Natural met by telephone on July 6, 2011, and			
22	determined a stipulated agreement was not possible. These parties agreed the matter			
23	should be presented to the Commission in two rounds of simultaneous comments.			
24	OAR 860-022-0070(6) specifies that if	parties cannot resolve any disputed issue		
25	by agreement, the parties are to file position statements with the Commission no later			
26	than August 1, 2011, and that the Commission is to decide the disputed issue by August

1	15, 2011. CUB, NWIGU, Staff, and NW Natural believe the Commission will benefit if			
2	rties have opportunity to respond to the position statements. Accordingly, these			
3	parties jointly ask the Administrative Hearings Division to adopt a procedural schedule			
4	for NW Natural's 2011 Spring Earnings Review that calls for Position			
5	Statements/Opening Comments on July 20, 2011, and Reply Comments on August 1,			
6	2011. An electronic draft of this motion was forwarded to all parties of Docket No. UM 903 a			
7 8	approximately 2:30 p.m. on July 6, 2011, with a request to contact counsel for Staff by 10 a.m.			
9	on Thursday, July 7, 2011, with any objection. No party to Docket No. UM 903 notified Staff			
10	counsel of an objection.
