8	The Public Utility Commission or Oregon Staff (Staff) respectfully requests that the		
9	attached Third Amended Stipulation be admitted to the UW 166 record and requests a		
10	Commission decision adopting the Third Amended Stipulation and amendment of Order No. 20-		
11	469's timeframe for a new general rate case. See ORS 756.568, see also OAR 860-001-		
12	0350(7)(b).		
13	In Order No. 17-123, the Commission a	dopted two stipulations to set rates for Roats	
14	Water System, Inc. (Roats). In the first Partial Stipulation, Roats and Staff (herein, Stipulating		
15	Parties) agreed that Roats would file a general rate case "no later than three years and six months		
16	after a final order is issued in this case, with a test year reflective of the Company's most recent		
17	full fiscal year of actuals." The Commission issued its final order on March 29, 2017, making		
18	the latest date for filing a general rate case under the terms of the first Partial Stipulation on or		
19	before September 29, 2020. On September 22, 2020, the Stipulating Parties filed an Amended		
20	Stipulation requesting a three month extension	of original stipulation's requirement for the	
21	Company to file a general rate case, requesting a date of January 1, 2021. As of the date of that		
22	filing, the Commission had not ruled on the Amended Stipulation. On December 11, 2020, the		
23	Parties filed a Second Amended Stipulation, wherein they agreed to an additional extension for		
24	filing a general rate case of no later than March 1, 2021. On December 11, 2020, the		
25	Commission issued Order No. 20-469, finding good cause to extend the time frame for the		
26	Company to issue a general rate case and amending Order No. 17-123 accordingly.		

1	All Stipulating Parties agreed to an additional extension of an additional two months for	
2	the filing of a general rate case. This additional extension is requested due to a construction	
3	project that the Company is completing for the City of Bend that has resulted in a decrease in the	
4	resources available for the Company to prepare the general rate case. As such, pursuant to the	
5	Third Amended Stipulation, Roats would be required to file a general rate case no later than May	
6	1, 2021.	
7	Because of the very limited nature of this Third Amended Stipulation and the plain	
8	meaning of the amendment, Staff respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge waive	
9	the requirement of an explanatory brief or supporting testimony. See OAR 860-001-0350(7)(a).	
10	For these reasons, Staff respectfully requests that the Third Amended Stipulation be	
11	admitted into the record and the Commission issue an order approving the Amended Stipulation	
12	without requiring an associated explanatory brief or supporting testimony.

9	authorized representative, William Roats, and the Public Utility Commission Staff (Staff)			
10	appearing by and through its attorney, Jill Goatcher, Assistant Attorney General agree to amend			
11	the Partial Stipulation filed on December 13, 2017 and amend Order No. 20-469. The Parties			
12	agree that Paragraph 5, Subsection B of the first Partial Stipulation should be amended. It states			
13	Roats will file a general rate case no later than three years and six months after a			
14	final order is issued in this case, with a test year reflective of the Company's most recent full fiscal year of actuals.			
15	The Commission issued its final order in this case, Order No. 17-123, on March 29, 2017.			
16	Therefore, Paragraph 5 requires the Company to file a general rate case no later than September			
17	29, 2020. On September 22, 2020, the Parties filed an Amended Stipulation, wherein they			
18	agreed to an extension for filing a general rate case of no later than January 1, 2021. On			
19	December 11, 2020, the Parties filed a Second Amended Stipulation, wherein they agreed to an			
20	additional extension for filing a general rate case of no later than March 1, 2021. On December			
21	11, 2020, the Commission issued Order No. 20-469, finding good cause to extend the time fram			
22	for the Company to issue a general rate case an	d amending Order No. 17-123 accordingly.		
23	The Parties agree that the Company sho	ould be granted a third and final extension to file a		
24	general rate case due to extenuating circumstances that have arisen since the second Amended

26	1 Staff originally filed the first Partial Stipulation on Dec (with new signature pages) the first Partial Stipulation or	cember 6, 2016, but due to technical difficulties, refiled a December 13, 2016 in its entirety.

1	Stipulation was filed. The Company indicated that it continues to need additional time to prepare		
2	for the general rate case filing due to a construction project for the City of Bend. This project		
3	has led to a decrease in the resources available to the Company necessary to prepare the general		
4	rate case. As a result, the Parties agree that the Company should not be required to file a general		
5	rate case before May 1, 2021. The Parties agree that Paragraph 5, Subsection B of the first		
6	Partial Stipulation should be amended to read:		
7	Roats will file a general rate case no later than May 1, 2021, with a test year reflective of		
8	the Company's most recent full fiscal year of actuals.
