4 The	nature and extent of the Petitioner's interest in the proceeding is:
	The Tribes are a party to the Klamath Hydroelectric Settlement Agreement (KHSA). The Tribes, through the KHSA and otherwise, support the KHSA's goal of removing dams from the Klamath River. This proceeding is consistent with that goal of the KHSA and is, in fact, a part of the process of pursuing that goal. As a party to the KHSA the Tribes are committed to supporting the surcharge under consideration here. The Tribes are also interested in reviewing PacifiCorp's economic analysis supporting the surcharge.

modern professional staff with expertise in the fields of fisheries, water quality, hydrology, and geomorphology.
