NATURE AND EXTENT OF THE PETITIONER'S INTEREST IN THE PROCEEDING:

Per OAR 860-038-0005, the Department is a designated member of the Portfolio Options Committee and since 2012, has served as Chair of the Committee. The Department's participation in the work of the Portfolio Options Committee, which includes review of voluntary renewable energy options for residential utility customers, supports the state's goal of encouraging a diverse array of sustainable energy sources under ORS 469.010. Additionally, under ORS 469.030, the Oregon Department of Energy ("ODOE") is statutorily charged with the responsibility to study, evaluate and disseminate information about energy use in Oregon. As part of these responsibilities, under ORS 469.060 ODOE is charged with making "recommendations for state and local governments to assist in the development and maximum use of cost-effective conservation and renewable resources, consistent with the energy policy stated in ORS 469.010 * * *." (ORS 469.060(3)(f)). In aid of that responsibility, ODOE "may intervene in any proceeding undertaken by an agency for the purpose of expressing its views as to the effect of an agency action, upon state energy resources and state energy policy." ORS 469.110(2).
