IF THE PETITIONER IS AN ORGANIZATION, THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS IN AND THE PURPOSES OF THE ORGANIZATION:

The City of Portland is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon. The City of Portland's home rule charter contains a broad grant of authority of all governmental powers, including the power commonly known as the police power, and to do any act necessary or approriate to carry out such power. The City represents the residents and electorate of the City, as well as the numerous businesses that are located and operate within the City to oversee the activities of utilities within its boundaries.

NATURE AND EXTENT OF THE PETITIONER'S INTEREST IN THE PROCEEDING:

The Commission has initiated this proceeding to investigate questions about fuel switching as related to energy efficiency incentives, including designs for incentives for space and water heating equipment, and issues of cost effectiveness from the customer and whole utility system perspective.

The City of Portland's 2009 Climate Action Plan establishes short- and long-term goals for carbon reduction. These goals are influenced by the emissions from generating electricity and use of natural gas. The City of Portland is pursuing multiple policy and regulatory avenues to address carbon reduction. For example, the City has cooperated with Multnomah County, the Energy Trust of Oregon, NW Natural, Portland General Electric and Pacific Power in establishing the Clean Energy Works program, to promote energy savings through low-interest financing to qualified homeowners to improve the energy efficiency of their homes. The policy decisions made in this proceeding may affect the City's goals and policies.

THE ISSUES THE PETITIONER INTENDS TO RAISE AT THE PROCEEDING:

The City of Portland intends to monitor and participate in this proceeding. If necessary, the City of Portland may raise issues as appropriate to this proceeding. The City of Portland's participation in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues in this proceeding. The City of Portland will bring a unique perspective to this proceeding. No other party can adequately represent the City of Portland's interests in this proceeding.

The City of Portland will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record or unreasonably delay the proceedings.

ANY SPECIAL KNOWLEDGE OR EXPERTISE OF THE PETITIONER THAT WOULD ASSIST THE COMMISSION IN RESOLVING THE ISSUES IN THE PROCEEDING:

The City of Portland has participated as a party in numerous dockets and matters before the Commission. The City of Portland brings a unique perspective to this proceeding. For example, the City of Portland's development of its Climate Action Plan gives both staff expertise and a community perspective on the carbon impact of fossil fuels.

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
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
