3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many of ICNU's members are customers of Portland General Electric Company ("PGE"), as shown on Attachment A.

4. On August 22, 2012, PGE filed an application with the Commission for an order approving the deferral of FAS 87 pension costs and carrying costs on cash contributions ("Application") in excess of the test year amount established in UE 215, its 2011 general rate case. The deferred amounts, which total approximately at \$12.9 million for 2012, would not immediately affect a change in PGE's rates; however, they would potentially be allowed in a subsequent proceeding. ICNU opposes the deferral and requests leave to intervene in this Docket to represent its members who would be affected by the deferral of PGE's costs.

5. ICNU has extensive experience with proceedings involving PGE's rates, including UE 208, UE 215, UE 228, and UE 250. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by

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any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. Therefore, it is in

the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition

to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
